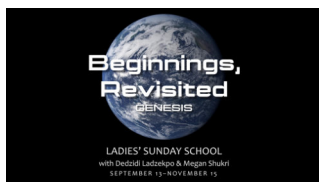
LABOR DAY WEEKEND

We will celebrate the Lord's Supper on Sunday morning, September 13.



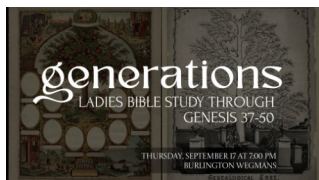
MEMBERS' MEETING
